LOCAL EXECUTIVE RECOGNIZED BY PHYSICIANS IN GEORGIA

ATLANTA – J.W. “Hank” Holderfield received the *Donna Glass Non-Physician Distinguished Service Award* at the Medical Association of Georgia’s (MAG) 155th House of Delegates meeting in Savannah on October 16 for contributions that are made to the advancement and support of medicine.

Holderfield is the president of Professional Association Management, Inc., a company that he founded in 1976 to provide specialized services to industry associations. This includes the DeKalb Medical Society (DMS), which nominated him for the award. In its nomination letter, DMS said that “his resume speaks very modestly of his tireless energy for the betterment of the society.”

Mr. Holderfield has served as chairman of the board of management for the Decatur/DeKalb YMCA. He also has been a member of the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta YMCA, the East DeKalb Rotary Club, the Physicians Care Clinic, and the Bike Ride Across Georgia organization. He served as chairman of the Agency Resource Group for the DeKalb County Board of Health.

He is a member of a number of societies, including the American Society of Association Executives, the Association of Component Dental Societies, and the American Association of Medical Society Executives. Mr. Holderfield is the only non-physician to be elected as an honorary member of the Georgia Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons. And he is a recipient of the DeKalb Medical Society’s highest award, the *Julius McCurdy Citizenship Award*.
