O R D E R


On Thursday, August 14, 2008, this Court held a telephonic conference in the captioned case. As memorialized in said conference, Plaintiffs' Motions for Leave to Amend the Complaint (doc. nos. 89, 101) and Defendants' Joint Motions for Protective Orders (doc. nos. 92, 96) are **GRANTED**. Defendants shall have a period of **thirty (30)** days from the date Plaintiffs file the amended complaint within which to plead or otherwise defend themselves in this action.¹

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall submit a proposed amended Joint Scheduling Order within **thirty (30)**

¹Although previously filed as an exhibit, Plaintiffs have indicated to the Court that they intend to file a final version of the amended complaint. The Plaintiffs are instructed to expeditiously do so, and the thirty day period shall run from the date this final version is filed.

days from the date of this Order. Discovery shall proceed immediately thereafter in accordance with the amended Joint Scheduling Order. All remaining motions in this case are **HEREBY TERMINATED AS MOOT.** (Doc. nos. 102, 103.)
